The ARIDO Awards program is one of the industry's most highly regarded honours, showcasing excellence, innovation and originality in interior design, as judged by leading members of business, media and design communities.

The winning design was for the first MoMA art exhibition shown at the gallery in the new home of the Toronto International Film Festival. The exhibit comprised drawings, sculptures, maquettes, videos and sculptural commissions by cinema auteur, Tim Burton.

IN8 collaborated with Barr Gilmore Art + Design to design the dynamic and compelling exhibition. IN8 is a strong believer in design collaboration, developing and working in integrated teams with architects, artists, other designers, engineers and many other experts.
